### SIGNATURE SCHOLARSHIPS AT BYU-IDAHO

A BYU-Idaho Signature Scholarship offers a way for you to support students and personally witness the tremendous impact you have in their lives. Three characteristics make a Signature Scholarship unique:

#### 1. Naming and Designation

A Signature Scholarship allows you to name your scholarship—for yourself, your organization, or a loved one. You may also designate your scholarship for students from one of four BYU-Idaho fundraising priorities.\*

#### 2. Annual Gathering

Each fall, Signature Scholarship donors are invited to campus to meet with scholarship recipients. This event, which may include a luncheon, gives you the opportunity to meet the students you support, hear about how the scholarships are blessing their lives, and build new friendships.

#### 3. Affordability

Whereas named scholarships are typically reserved for large endowments, Signature Scholarships are feasible for donors in many financial situations. They can be started with a donation of \$10,000, which generally will fund two students for two semesters. The university encourages providing this support for four years.\*\*
